

From Browns Valley East Township, the 2011 Big Stone SWCD Conservation Farmer is Scott Doschadis and his mate Donna Jorgens. They farm approximately 1100 acres of no till alternating corn, beans, and wheat. Scott has been farming since the early 1980s and moved to his present farmstead in 1996 when his father retired from farming. Grampa Doschadis homesteaded here in the early 1940s. Scott has his farm involved in the CSP program. He has the maximum 391 acres enrolled in EQIP and recently installed ½ acre of field windbreak trees through CRP. His future plans include removing more acreage of old grove and replacing with new trees. Scott is also planning to construct a grass waterway through one of his fields through EQIP. This will reduce field erosion and wasteful runoff. Congratulations, Scott and Donna!
