

## Seasonal Conservation Technician

Big Stone SWCD is looking to fill a Seasonal Position with flexible start and end dates. Main duties will be to help with field season which includes but is not limited to; tree planting, fabric laying, tube installation, grass seeding, cover crop seeding, well monitoring, carpentry, mechanical, and cleaning duties. Position will work outside mostly; spraying invasive weeds and talking with landowners about weed management while keeping records of chemical used and billing those customers. In the office duties will be, but are not limited to; filling out spray reports, writing up spray bills, ordering materials, filing paperwork as assigned, and helping direct landowners who walk in the door on any range of topics. Position will have the opportunity to meet many different agencies and shadow all aspects of conservation, mainly in the agricultural region. Regulatory programs such as the buffer law will be introduced as well as wetland and drainage laws. District will provide Instruction on use of trucks with trailers, ATVs, tractors, and survey equipment and will be utilized often during the course of work. Applicant may be required to loft 60 lb bags above the head at times, and numerous leaning and bending on uneven ground will be required. Priority will be given to the applicant who has already secured an herbicide applicators license.

Position will start at \$12.00/hour/maximum of 40 hours per week.
